### **ARBITRATION DATE SET FOR DETENTION AND CORRECTIONS WORK WEEK ISSUE**

On Tuesday July 13, 2010, SEBA met with the County regarding the Detention and Corrections Bureau Schedule Change. SEBA proposed the 12 hour shift 80 hour work period with a **Sunset Clause** after 36 months returning to the 12 hour shift 84 hour work period schedule, and the County began by proposing an 8 hour shift 80 hour work period. The County did make a second proposal of 12 hour shift 80 hour work period with **no Sunset Clause**. This second offer by the County is their Last Best and Final offer. No agreement was reached.

An arbitration date has been set for Monday, July 19, 2010. The arbitrator will be deciding the following question:

***Does the Sheriff's Department have the right to change the schedule for Detention and Corrections Bureau from a 12 hour shift 84 hour work period to a 12 hour shift to an 80 hour work period?***

Once SEBA has the arbitrator's decision a SEBA FLASH will be sent out.
