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### **Detention and Corrections**

### **Schedule Arbitration Decision**

SEBA received mediator/arbitrator David Hart's decision regarding the work schedules for the Detention and Corrections Bureau. Mr. Hart concluded that the 12/80 schedules will apply to Detentions and Corrections Bureau and Type 1 Jails designated by the Sheriff or designee.

Mr. Hart went on to say the Safety and Safety Management Unit members assigned to the 12/80 schedule in Detentions and Corrections Bureau and Type 1 Jails, will be regularly scheduled to work 80 hours in a pay period, comprised of six (6) 12-hour shifts and one (1) 8-hour shift during the pay period.

The Sheriff's Department will perform a one-time review of the 12-hour 80-hour work period schedule three (3) years after implementation. There will be no further meet and confer obligation on the part of the Sheriff's Department, and the Department will have the sole authority to determine whether to continue this schedule. No further reviews of the scheduling are granted.

**Therefore beginning August 28, 2010 the schedule for the Detention and Corrections Bureau will be a 12-hour shift 80-hour work-period.**
